The Environmental Education Center's annual trip to Cape May will take place this September. Join us for warm water, seasonal weather, excellent birding, and plenty of open shops and restaurants to visit. September is a great time to see Neotropical migrants such as warblers, orioles, tanagers, and more before they journey south, and is a very pleasant time of year to be in Cape May.

Touring three days and two nights will give us ample opportunity to be in the middle of bird migration action! Accommodations will be at the beachfront, Marquis de Lafayette, which is within walking distance of restaurants, cafes, and delis. A full complimentary breakfast will be available each morning. "Happy stops" will be included each day for the purchasing of lunch, drinks, and snacks.
