We are again pleased to offer *Guest Instructor Clinics* on Mondays at 8:30pm. These five week “clinics” are lessons taught by outside instructors. Registration will begin Saturday, March 11th, online, by phone or in person.

Fees for each five week session are \$200 for Somerset County residents, \$235 for non-county ID/grandfathered riders, and \$275 for out of county riders. Riders may give three horse choices.
