Nancy R. Jones, "Jonesie," will be teaching both jumping and flat classes on Friday evenings:

Jonesie is a life-long resident of Morris County and has been involved in the equine industry for most of her life. From retraining ex-racehorses to attending horse shows and foxhunts, Jonesie's plethora of knowledge and experience has proven to be instrumental in helping many levels of riders to become better horsemen. Specifically, Jonesie caters to those individuals looking to further their education in the horsemanship surrounding hunt seat equitation, hunters, jumpers, and basic dressage. Her philosophy is a simple one: the horse should always come first. Prior to establishing her own Logan's Brook Inc., Jonesie managed a breeding and training stable for Clarence and Tania Nagro for over twenty-five years. She has trained and turned out many successful equestrians, most notably Jessica Suida, who rode in the Nation's Cup and competed for the Norwegian Equestrian team.
