

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Programs are open to kids with a developmental disability who reside in a participating municipality in Somerset County. (Call the TR office at 908 526-5650 to verify municipal eligibility or visit us at www.somersetcountyparks.org).
- Individuals registering for kids programs must be 9 years of age at the start of a specific program, able to take their own medication, and independent in personal care. There will be no nurse for these programs.
- If you are applying for a scholarship, you must submit a deposit of \$25.00 per week long session when registering. Additional paperwork will then be sent to you for completion if necessary.

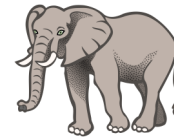

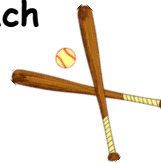
