A SUMMER DAY PROGRAM  
FOR CHILDREN WITH  
LEARNING DISABILITIES,  
ASPERGER'S SYNDROME,  
HIGH FUNCTIONING AUTISM,  
OR A MILD INTELLECTUAL  
DISABILITY  
(AGES 9 - 21)





This summer program offers six (6) one week sessions for children ages 9 - 21 from July 12 - August 20. Each week will be a different theme and consist of a variety of hands-on activities including but not limited to arts and crafts, sports and games, science, music, and theatre.

- A minimum of 10 children per week is required or the program will be cancelled.
- 20 participants maximum per week.
- Program will be held outdoors unless there is inclement weather.
- Program is structured and designed for children with a learning disability, Asperger's Syndrome, high functioning autism, or a mild/moderate Intellectual disability. All applicants are screened for appropriateness. This program is not appropriate for those with oppositional defiant behavior and/or a history of aggression or a likelihood of aggression.
- Attendees must be able to function in a group setting of 10 participants to 2 staff. All participants must be independent in all areas of personal care, able to administer their own medication, and toilet trained.
- Anyone new to the TR department will require an assessment by the TR staff and it may be required for anyone that does not regularly participate in the TR programs. Transportation is not provided.
- Proof of eligibility for Special Education Services and a copy of your child's IEP may be requested. Final acceptance into the program is at the discretion of TR staff.
- It is at the discretion of the TR staff to determine if your child is appropriate for the program in order for the experience to be fun and safe for all children and staff.
- Covid guidelines will be in place. The Therapeutic Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel or modify the program based on the Governor's Executive Orders, CDC guidelines or NJ Department of Health guidelines.

**Program Fees: \$200.00 per week: TR participating municipality**  
**\$275.00 per week: Non - TR participating municipality**

### **REGISTRATION**

Registration is on a first-come first-serve basis by phone only with a credit card. Deposit of \$200 is due at time registration. We will be accepting registration beginning on Wednesday, May 12 from 5:30 - 7:00pm and daily through Wednesday, June 9th at 12:00pm. Deposit will only be refunded if the TR staff finds your child ineligible for the program or if the program is cancelled. **RECEIPT OF THIS BROCHURE DOES NOT IMPLY ELEGIBILITY.**
